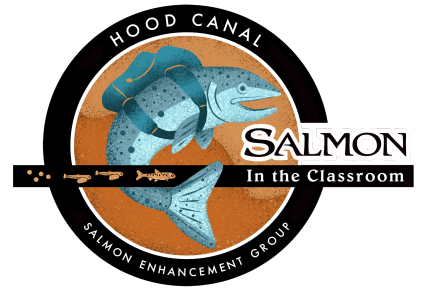


"I SPY" IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD



MATERIALS:

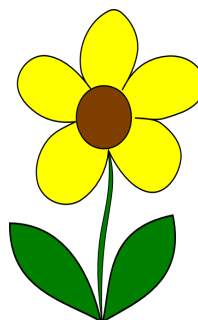
- I Spy Scavenger hunt

- Go into your neighborhood or backyard and see how many of these items you can find

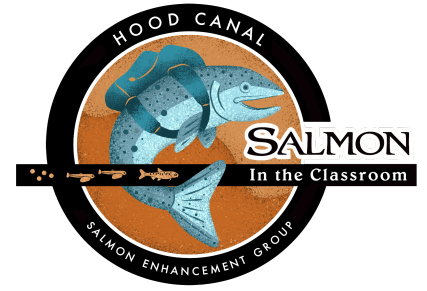
TIPS:

6-8 YEARS OLD IN TOWN SETTINGS:

1. 3 flowers that are different colors
2. A tree with lots of leaves
3. a piece of trash that you can recycle
4. 2 different animals
5. 2 cars of the same color
6. A large sign
7. 3 items that are smaller than your thumb
8. A cool shaped rock
9. Something that is blue
10. Something that smells good

7. A new flower you could look up the name of
8. Moss growing
9. An insect in the dirt
10. A cloud in the sky shaped as something
