“WHAT TIME IS IT, SALMON?”

(AGES: 6-8) (ADAPTATION TO “WHAT TIME IS IT, MR FOX?”)

MATERIALS:

- **Boundary Markers (cones, backpack, sweatshirt, etc)**

HOW TO PLAY:

- 1. Set a rectangular area with 4 boundary lines with everyone lined up on one short end with one person in the middle as “Salmon” who will stand with their back towards the players lined up on the end.**
- 2. The players lined up at the end will yell “what time is it, Salmon?” and whatever time they say is however many steps the players must take.**
 - a. The steps must be regular steps and not teeny tiny or giant steps.**
- 3. At any time, Salmon may yell “dinner/lunch time” for their answer and try and tag as many people as they can.**
- 4. Once tagged, you are out for the remainder of the game along the long lines of the boundary.**
- 5. If anyone was not tagged, they can line up again at the end of the boundaries and play another round until there is one last person to ask.**
- 6. That last person not caught is the winner can then become Salmon if they choose.**
