Summary:

The Hood Canal Salmon Enhancement Group is a nonprofit organization located at the Salmon Center in Belfair, WA. We are a 38 acre non-profit learning center located at a historic site on the shores of Hood Canal where a portion of the land has been restored to native estuary in an effort to improve salmon habitat. Our mission is to deepen the connection between land, people, and salmon through restoration, education, and research.

The Education/Outreach Intern will assist in established education and outreach programs as well as events in classroom and on-site settings. Interns will have the opportunity to be involved with salmon enhancement and sustainable agriculture projects, while assisting in the development and execution of summer education programs to fit the needs of the organization and the community. The Salmon Center utilizes formal and non-formal curriculum to educate the community and classrooms in the surrounding school districts.

Eligibility:

- Must be enrolled in college, university, or a certificate program
- Must have a valid driver's license and reliable transportation to and from The Salmon Center
- Must pass a background check

Applicant should be:

- A dependable individual that demonstrates strong leadership skills
- Detail oriented, with a positive attitude and excellent communication/people skills
- Experienced with teaching and working with K-12 youth
- Comfortable in a group setting

Terms of Employment:

Hours per week: 10-40 hours/week

Internship Stipend Rate Sheet

Salmon Center internships are available to students enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate, or continuing education program where they receive school credits and monetary stipend for their time. Internship opportunities have flexible time commitments along with corresponding credit hours and stipends. Students must coordinate with their school or advisor in advance to ensure they receive school credit for their internship. Stipends are awarded upon completion of hours.

Time Commitment (based on a 10 week quarter)	Stipend
100 hours; ~ 10 hrs/week	\$250.00
200 hours; ~ 20 hrs/week	\$500.00
300 hours; ~ 30 hrs/week	\$750.00
400 hours; ~ 40 hrs/week	\$1000.00

Stipends will be distributed in two installments upon the completion of committed contract hours. The first payment will be distributed at midterm (of internship) and the last payment will be distributed at end of term.*

**Start and end dates of projects may not necessarily coincide with quarterly school schedules. Start and end dates and/or weekly hour commitment for internships are negotiable but must be determined before work commences.*
